



The Research Division of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis offers dissertation internships to Ph.D. students in economics. The internship targets students with strong research interest and scholarly work comparable to those in top research institutions. The purpose of the internship program is to increase the students' experience and exposure to scholarly research.

Students are expected to make significant progress on their dissertation while at the Bank and are expected to make one formal presentation during their stay. The students will be expected to interact with the research economists at the Bank as well as visiting Washington University faculty and various other visiting scholars.

### **Qualifications/Skills**

- Applications are open to Ph.D. students from all Ph.D.-granting colleges and universities.
- Applicants must have passed their qualifying examinations and must be at the dissertation stage of their program.

### **To Apply**

We are currently accepting applications for the 2016 positions. The application deadline is **March 14, 2016**.

To apply, applicants must complete both of the following steps:

1. Complete the online application for the dissertation intern position at <http://careers.stlouisfed.org/>.

To this application, the following documents must be uploaded in PDF or Word format:

- cover letter
  - curriculum vitae
  - dissertation proposal
